**UPDATE ON THIS PAST MEDICAL MISSION TRIP - March 9-16, 2019**



A *MEDICAL MISSION TEAM* of eight arrived on March 9th. Marie Gabriel (Founder of Haiti's Child) was there to greet us and coordinate the safe travel to our land. We were joined by two medical students, Dr. Anderson and Dr. Angela, who served as our Haitian doctors. Reggie, Pharadia, and Jenny were our faithful interpreters. Marie's sister Josie and her daughter Bianca flew in from Georgia to also help. During the month prior to our trip, Haiti had a series of rallies and protests which closed down the country for 12 days. After much prayer, we boarded and traveled via Jet Blue direct from Boston to Port-au-Prince. The medical clinic was set up in our church and ran as usual!

This year the village people of LaMothe were in even *MORE NEED THAN USUAL* because of the government unrest and shut downs. We were hopeful and determined to be able to hand out as many bags of beans and rice as we could. And we did it! Praise God! What a blessing to see people walk out of our clinic with both medications and food this year. We were able to treat almost 500 people in the clinic, examined about 200 school children, and actually lost count of how many people received rice and beans - maybe 700!

## T H E   R O O F   I S   G O I N G   U P !



*THANKS* to the many fundraising efforts and the generosity of our Bristol Rotarians over the past two years, we are ready to complete construction of the school's second floor roof. We actually began the process early in January, as some materials were purchased and delivered to the land. Our American engineer was also scheduled to fly in to oversee a crew that planned to begin the work in February. Unfortunately, due to the violence, unrest, and cancelled flights to Haiti, it all came to a halt. Road blocks and dangerous travel within Haiti made it difficult for the workers to get to the land.

*THE GOOD NEWS* is that things started to calm back down in Haiti early March (our medical mission team was actually able to go last minute), and the roof project has been rescheduled to this coming summer! It takes a lot of coordination and effort to get a plan in place, but once everything is in place, it shouldn't take more than a month to complete the whole project!

*WE ARE CONFIDENT THAT GOD* will lead us to complete this roof project and we will move on to the next! Once the roof is complete, the next step will be to raise funds to install the windows and apply the final finish to the second floor.
